Root Cause(s): What is the heart of the issue? What evidence supports this conclusion?

ACT Aspire (2022- 2023) results indicate 45% of 6th - 8th grade students performed at the *Ready* or *Exceeding* level; therefore, 55% of our students performed below the expected level.

iReady (2023-24) End-of-Year Diagnostic results indicate 46% of 6th - 8th grade students performed at grade level; therefore, 54% of our students performed below the expected level.
